Would you like to volunteer at the Thrift Shop? Here is what being a Thrift Shop volunteer means:

Working with at least one other person for a once weekly 2 1/2 hour shift at the shop on Rt. 28 in Dennisport. The morning shift is 10-12:30 and the afternoon shift is 12:30-3:00. We would like to be open Tuesday through Saturday, closed Sunday and Monday. That goal requires 20 people. When at Shop tasks are varied and each volunteer seems to find his or her niche of what they most like to do. Tasks include such things as vacuuming, dusting, organizing, sorting and pricing donations, greeting customers, accepting payment and making change, bagging purchased items, tallying money at end of day, setting up special tables or window displays.

New volunteers can be assigned to work with seasoned volunteer who will provide orientation and training.

There are substitutes for when you need a week off or days can be exchanged if needed....you are a VOLUNTEER after all
